Training Session with students 8th -22nd Sep, 2014

These session included awareness programs, peer-counseling session, attendant ship training. The objective of all these sessions and activities was to create understanding about disability and inclusive education for all. Through these sessions students have a chance to know about how persons with disabilities especially women with disabilities manage their routine.





Capacity Building & DET Training 29 Sep 2014: Visited a new launched DPO by the name of Sayyad Welfare Foundation in Mardan



Saaya Association organized DET training to Sayyad Welfare Foundation in Mardan. Mr. Asim Zafar gave Lecture on disability and Mechanism of Developing a DPO. The Saaya team including its members with cross disabilities shared their life stories and their journey on wheels that helped the local community to get better understanding of disability as a life style. The whole event was a collection of different activities to keep everyone active throughout the training program.

Wheelchair Distribution 26 Sep 2014

We often take the ability to move in our home and community for granted. Mobility enhances a person's ability to learn, interact with others, earn a living and participate in the community. Saaya Association of Person with Disabilities has distributed wheelchairs among the persons (children, women) with disabilities by the support of community. OCTOBER 2014

White Cane Safety Day 15 Oct 2014

White Cane Day is being celebrated on October 15 to acknowledge the abilities of people who are blind and to promote equal opportunities. The basic mission of White Cane Day is to educate the world about blindness. To acknowledge that blind and visually impaired can live and work independently while giving back to their communities. Be acquainted with this day, a small activity was held at Saaya Office in which FJU students participated actively.

Symbolically, covering their eyes, experiencing the feelings of Visually Impaired person that how they manage their life by using white cane.





Training on Independent Living and Awareness Session on Disability & Role of DPOs for Community Mobilizer 17 -18Oct 2014

The two days training session was conducted by Saaya Association at its office held on 17-18 Oct 2014. Mr. Sayyad Khan, President Sayyad welfare foundation from Mardan with his team visited Saaya Office to gain some more knowledge about working & capacity building of DPOs.





The main propose of this session was to highlight the role of DPO's in Society. Ms. Saima Aslam has briefed & shared to the participants regarding the role of DPOs in community and told them about the working of Saaya Association.

Polio Day 24 Oct 2015

Pakistan accounted for 86% of the global wild poliovirus (WPV) case count in 2014. Pakistan is the only country to have reported a dramatic increase in cases during the year 2013. In 2014, polio affected forty-four districts (23 in 2013) from three provinces/areas. Every year World Polio Day is celebrated on 24 Oct .To highlight the issue related to Polio and to aware the parents who refuse to give polio vaccination to their children to avoid the hazard of disability. Saaya Association Team organized a Polio awareness walk with the students of Quaid-i-Azam University in Islamabad.





International Disability Day 3rd Dec 2014

On the occasion of 3rd December Saaya association in collaboration with other DPO's from the different cities of Pakistan participated in a peace awareness walk under the umbrella of Community Based Inclusive Development CBID network at Lahore. The main purpose of this walk was to aware the society, general public and specially towards Government to express their disappointment from the current Government and showed their unity to refuse the consent of committee (Law & Justice).





Persons with disabilities have struggled for the last many year, unfortunately Government has not realized and recognized the need of persons with disabilities and therefore rejected and, confiscated our rights to come forward and work for Inclusive Society. It is the basic right of Persons with disability to be rehabilitated, employed and empowerment according to the ordinance 1981. The government has proven that we are not even in the list of consideration, to be empowered.

Awareness Program 16 Dec 2014 at COMSAT UNIVERSITY

On the occasion of International World disability day, Saaya Association and Comsats University have arranged an awareness program in Islamabad. Students were sensitized on the disability issues and inclusion of persons with disabilities. Mr. Asim Zafar President Saaya Association delivered lecture on disability where he provoked students to think about disability and concept of independent living. He described the history of independent living movement and its contribution in the lives of persons with disabilities.





Ms. Saima Aslam a woman with disability from Saaya Association related her life history with disability; she described how independent living has changed her life. Learning self-management skills has helped her to be independent in life, without being burden on others. She performs her daily living chores using personal assistant and with her electric wheelchair, she can move freely in society and contribute as productive part. Awareness Cricket match between Saaya wheelchair team & student of COMSAT university was played.

March 2015

Observance of International Women Day 8 March 2015

Each year around the world, International Women's Day (IWD) is celebrated on March 8. Thousands of events occur not just on this day but throughout March to mark the economic, political and social achievements of women. Organizations, governments, charities, educational institutions, women's groups, corporations and the media celebrate the day. Many groups around the world choose different themes each year relevant to global and local gender issues. To achieve the objective in year 2015 for the first time, the Day was being commemorated under a general theme 'MAKE IT HAPPEN'.

An event of women day was organized by Saaya Association of person with disabilities and National forum of women with disabilities (NFWWD) under the umbrella of CBID Network on 4th March 2015. Around 25 Women with Disabilities participated from Rawalpindi and Islamabad. Main purpose to organize this outreach activity was to provide an opportunity to Women with Disabilities to socialize, as there are fewer opportunities for them to go to public places.





Ms. Saima Aslam National Coordinator NFWWD& Director Project of Saaya expressed her views and said, Saaya & NFWWD has provided an opportunity for Women with Disabilities to be together and have fun at Cinepax Centaurs. She added, whatever disability you have it never stops you from socializing. Issue only comes when you do not have acceptance of your strengths and weaknesses, whether you are a person with or without disabilities .Our today's activity is a proof that we have ways to move ahead. Especially, when it comes to the development of a country, give due rights to women. Women with Disabilities should equally get the chance to put their part in the progress.

This time we have celebrated the day on a small scale but I wish we could arrange it on a broader level next time. Ms. Abia Akram (CEO NFWWD) also expressed her thoughts with the gathering. Such activities should be organized after every 2-3 months. Women with Disabilities should get opportunity to meet people so they can coordinate to come into mainstream. All Women with Disabilities also shared their views and showed interest in such activities. They enjoyed the movie time and lunch. At the end, Ms. Saima thanked administration of Centaurus cinepax, Saaya Association of persons with disabilities, NFWWD and CBID Network, who helped and provided support in organizing such event.

April 2015

National Wheelchair Cricket Tournament 23-25 April 2015

Opening Ceremony & welcome dinner 24 Apr, 2015

6th All Pakistan National Wheelchair Cricket tournament was organized by Saaya Association (Islamabad), Milestone (Lahore) & DWA (Karachi) under the Umbrella of CBID Network in which 10 teams (including 2 teams of Women with disabilities) from different DPO's participated.

15% of the total population of Pakistan is disabled persons and this marginalized community still suffers lack of facilitation and proper knowledge of managing lives with disability. Like other facilitations, this segment of society has kept behind in healthy activities too like sports. They in fact are not considered healthy enough to participate in any outdoor sports but credit goes to the Disabled Persons Organizations who made it happen in the well befitting manner, the Role of DPOs in collaboration with other organization introducing and promoting sports for persons with disabilities can never be denied.

Disabled persons organization incepted this idea of sports for persons with disabilities in Pakistan and executed it in the well manner, practically organizing sports festival across the country they proved that self-done is well done. This event was organized to display that the abilities of people with disabilities are no less than anyone else in the society. Through this meaningful event, community, parents, teachers, students and public were sensitized.

Seminar on International Day of Person with disabilities at FJU 3rd December 2015





This year the seminar on International Day of Persons (3rd December) with Disabilities Saaya Association Islamabad has organized a seminar in collaboration with Department of Behavioral Sciences, FJWU. The topic of the event is "Inclusion matters: access and empowerment of people of all abilities". The session was split into three sessions. First one was on Disability & Development by Asim Zafar (CEO Saaya Association), Experience sharing as women with disabilities by Ms. Saima Aslam (National Coordinator of National Forum of Women with Disability, Director Project Saaya Association) and Inclusive Education/ Identifying strategies to promote Inclusive education in Pakistan by Dr. Shahnawaz Munami (Ophthalmologist by profession, National Coordinator Community Based Inclusive Development (CBID Network Pakistan). The university management discussed about Disability Sensitization at University Level & Its Future Plan.

WORKSHOP FOR MANUAL & ELECTRIC WHEELCHAIRS MAINTENANCE, THREE WHEELS MOTORBIKE

Up to 80% of persons with disability live in isolated rural areas in the developing world including Pakistan. WHO, WB and UN also estimates suggests 15% disability rate in developing countries including Pakistan. According to national census 1998, the population with disability is 3,286,630 (which are 2.49 %) of the total population in Pakistan. After the base line survey, it has come to know that in the area of Islamabad and Rawalpindi persons with disabilities do not have access over resources, education, adequate health facilities, any access to assistive devices regarding their mobility, and less participation in society and income generating activities.

Saaya Association has started Independent living center and Workshop for Manual & Electric wheelchairs maintenance, three wheels motorbike. Saaya Association has received used electric wheelchairs as a donation from Sakura Wheelchairs project (Japan) with the support of Milestone for persons with severe with disabilities to increase their mobility. In Pakistan wheelchairs manufacturing by medical manufactures or suppliers, there is no facility for maintenance of wheelchairs. This workshop/independent living center managed by persons with disability themselves. The electric wheelchairs were repaired at Saaya mobility workshop and distributed among needy and deserving persons with disabilities.

FEW OF THE SUCCESS STORIES ARE BELOW,

Mr. Fayyaz Yousuf

Mr. Fayyaz Yousuf is a 42 year old gentleman. He is MSc. Chemistry and used to make his living off a very handsome job as pharmaceutical Quality Check manager. Unfortunately met a road accident (2008), resulted spinal cord injury (level C paraplegic) and lost his lower limbs. He had been living in a very miserable life after accident, as there was no one there to motivate him back towards life and raise his awareness



towards living a life on wheels. Mr. Asim Zafar from Saaya Association approached him on 20th July 2014. It was a very encouraging counseling session and after a meeting of almost three hours Mr. Fayyaz Yousuf was totally a different person. In the end He was presented with Sakura's provided electric wheelchair that no doubt improved his mobility on much extent. Now Mr. Fayyaz is living a very better life on wheels while his family pays their special thanks to SAKURA and SAAYA association for changing one's life to a better state.

Mr. Sayyad khan

Mr. Sayyad khan has been a very dedicated disability movement activist since he got to know about disability and life. Being a POLIO victim he has been contributing in the movement for the last five years and has established his own DPO called as Mr. Sayyad welfare association in Mardan KPK province of Pakistan. Mobility has been a major issue for him especially living in those rural areas of province. His dedication is that much to the level that he sold away his only patch of land for the cause. Acknowledging his relentless efforts in the movement He was invited to the SAAYA office and was presented with the SAKURA's provided electric wheelchair. After getting the wheelchair his mobility has been ensured and no wonder his contributions to the cause are going to get a sudden boost after the utilization of this amazing gadget.



Mr. Usman Bin Nayyar

Mr. Usman Nayyar has been our very dedicated member of the movement for last two years now. Usman is a graduate with double Maths and Statistics. When he joined Saaya he was not much into life and was disappointed as he had covered most part of his life on legs but with the time Muscular dystrophy got more severe and finally was on wheels. One of the beautiful



gadgets that Sakura sent us, was presented to Usman as well. Usman has been getting maximum benefit of this wheelchair and has been going out buying his stuff himself. He is contributing in disability movement at Saaya Association as great role model.

Mr. Muhammad Karamatullah Khan

Mr. Karamatullah khan is a 35 year old graduate and works in a DPO called Helpful Organization for Special talent HOST based in Baluchistan as a rehabilitation officer. He was diagnosed with a quadriplegic disability after a road accident a few years back. He's been a profound human rights activist after his disability but mobility has been a major issue for him. Mr. Asim Zafar acknowledged his services in the movement and was presented with an electric wheelchair provided by Sakura. He has been working even more efficiently after the provision of assistive device. Thought there are more



severely disabled people who are still waiting for the provision of such devices and are looking forward to that.

Ms. Sumaira Tabbassum

Ms. Sumaira Tabbassum is a teacher by profession and giving her best services in a Government College after completing her Master's in Education. She along with her two siblings suffers with muscular dystrophy and has led a very tough life managing her education with her increasing disability. She has been a very active member of Saaya association for over 4 years now but mobility has been a major issue for her. Especially when she had to go college as her disability is increasing every next day coming. Saaya



presented her the electric wheelchair provided by Sakura and her mobility has been improved a big time after the availability of this handy gadget. Sumaira is now one of the successful stories of Saaya association contributing her best services in the disability movement in Pakistan being in the Pakistan women with disabilities wing.

Mr. Israr Ahmed

Mr. Israr Ahmed is a senior Cameraman in a popular TV channel and has been doing a very good job with his camera. Unfortunately, in a road accident he got a serious spinal cord injury and got his lower limbs paralyzed. Times have been very tough on him after accident and he was about to lose his job. Someone told him about Saaya association and he got in contact with the organization. After the availability of electric wheelchair he's keeping his job as a cameraman and making living for his children.

Being the only son of his parents a brother of a sister his parents have always been worried about him. Could not get him admission in any institute so they admitted him to a madrassa where he completed his Hifz-e-Quran. Sadly both the parents left the siblings a year back. Times have been very tough after the death of parents, so Mr. Saleem always wanted to go out and make up for his living. Mobility always have been a major issue as due to weak muscles he couldn't even use a manual wheelchair. He contacted Saaya through some reference and after the assessment of his disability and need he was given an electric wheelchair that was altered according to his physical ease and need. After having this gadget his mobility has increased to a level



and now he can go out to visit his only asset, some cultivated land that was inherited by his father.
